













FLOORPLAN FIRST FLOOR

THE ATHLETICS AND WELLNESS CENTRE

A school's gymnasium is the heart of its community. It is the hub around which all parts of the school revolve. It provides a space for sports; to develop a culture of fitness and healthy living; for student-life, including dances and assemblies; and for the performing arts, providing a venue in which students can rehearse and showcase their talents.

The new Athletics and Wellness Centre will provide much needed physical education space, while also providing our teams with the best training facilities and an unparalleled environment, promoting community and school spirit.

Belonging to a community plays a vital role in leading a happy and successful life and this building will connect us all. It will support our student education priorities identified in the strategic plan: personalized learning, creative and critical thinking, wellness-balance-breadth, future-readiness, and character development. It will help us achieve our goal of providing a well-balanced education. Building the Athletics and Wellness Centre is the next step in our evolution and a step towards fulfilling our vision for Aberdeen Hall and for our students.



FAB LAB - DESIGN STUDIO

With the opening of our new Athletic and Wellness Centre, our current Gym Studio located in the Senior School will be transformed into a state of the art 2,000 square foot design studio. The Fab Lab will allow students to engage in the design process from inception to completion. They will use computers, hand tools, 3D printers and computer aided design and manufacturing equipment to plan, create and refine practical solutions to real world problems.

This purpose built space will include:



Robotics Centre

Students will have a space to build, program and modify robots. Sample projects include building autonomous robots to navigate through obstacle courses.



Wood Shop

With a focus on hand tools, students will learn about the application of technical drawings, geometry, trigonometry and algebra in a tangible, hands-on setting. Sample projects include carving a functional paddle and creating habitable bat boxes.



Production Graphics

Students will learn about the creation of 2D graphics and then render them into a product. Sample projects include making a customized short on the short press and creating custom decals on the vinyl cutter.

3D Fabrication

Computer aided design and manufacturing skills will help students to design and create 3D objects.



Media Lab

Students will have access to a variety of AV equipment (tripods, lighting, digital cameras, etc) and computers to create, edit and refine photo and video projects. Sample projects include creating animations of biological processes such as photosynthesis and cellular respiration.



Design Centre

This station would afford students a large work space to ideate. Sample projects include creating larger technical drawings by hand and using computer software to create 2D and 3D models.

The fastest, most simple way to support Aberdeen Hall. Gifts of Stock

Donations of publicly traded securities (i.e. shares, bonds or units of mutual funds), transferred to Aberdeen Hall are fully exempt from capital gains tax.

To make a gift of securities, the easiest and most cost-effective way to do so is to transfer the gift directly to Aberdeen Hall.

You will receive a charitable tax receipt for the full market value of the donated securities on the day that the shares are received.
