## **LOOKING AHEAD**

Dear Aberdeen Hall Community,

We sincerely hope that you have enjoyed the summer break thus far, and are recharging your batteries for September. Last year was a challenging, but successful year and we are looking forward to starting a new chapter that will include an opportunity to begin to look back on the pandemic. At this point, the Ministry of Education is hopeful that we will enter Stage 1, which is defined as: "full-time in-class instruction for all students in all grades. No learning group or density requirements."

An update is scheduled from the Ministry of Education on or about August 15, 2021. We will share this information with you as soon as possible. In June, there were some serious discussions about lifting all mask requirements for school settings, but again the Ministry will be working closely with Interior Health to make the final recommendations in mid August.

The last 17 months have certainly been very different from other school years, but we are optimistic that during the next few months, we will be able to recreate the normalized learning environment of which we are accustomed.

As I have mentioned in the past, I am very grateful to be a part of our Aberdeen Hall community. The kindness, strength and resilience exhibited over the course of the last year has been exceptional. We all learned many lessons that will benefit us as we move forward.

When asked about what she learned during the challenges of the pandemic, my youngest daughter expressed that she is now "more in the moment". Before the pandemic, she said she would primarily work for the weekends, and the

next big event, but since the pandemic, she has learned to enjoy smaller events and have a greater day-to-day presence. Because of the reduced pace of life and fewer options, she has learned to enjoy the smaller things. A valuable lesson I believe for someone in their early twenties.



We would like to thank those of you who have completed the diversity, equity and inclusion survey from the spring. We are meeting this month as a team to further review the feedback and coordinate our school's pluralism strategies for the coming one to three years. As part of our August professional development series, all employees will be taking part in workshops about identifying biases and inclusive strategies while teaching.

Re-establishing community connection - We are excited to welcome parents back into the halls, and meet personally for Guild meetings and grade parent meet-ups. The human connection was greatly missed and will be welcomed back with enthusiasm. There is a certain chemistry that can only be achieved when we gather in person, especially when it comes to schools and the development of our students. Advancing from lessons learned while teaching through the pandemic - Further exploration of teaching strategies and learning opportunities developed during the pandemic has strengthened our faculty's repertoire of progressive teaching methods, and our goal is to achieve an optimal balance of new and time proven techniques to enhance learning.

In closing, I would like to offer a sincere note of appreciation to our students, parents and employees for working so well together to persevere and maintain a positive "can do" approach. Because of this, we are excited about what the future holds.
