PRESCHOOL INSTRUCTIONS

The school uniform for Preschool students consists of navy and white. Students may wear navy shorts or navy pants. As well, the girls may wear navy skorts or the school plaid tunic. Navy ankle socks are worn with the pants and shorts and navy knee-high socks or tights are worn with the skorts and tunics. In addition, they wear a white or navy top (which can be a crested polo shirt).

Preschool Cardigan Requirement: Preschool students are required to purchase the official school cardigan from the Uniform Shop. This cardigan must be worn on Mondays, for Picture Days, during formal events, and as needed for cold weather.

A substantial shoe is required for outdoor play, this may be the shoes worn to school and runners are preferred. For class time, each child needs to have a pair of black indoor shoes that are light-weight and easy to put on. Rubber soled, canvas slip-on runners are the best and will serve as “gym shoes” as well.

A change of uniform coloured clothing, labelled in a plastic bag can be kept at school.



JUNIOR SCHOOL INSTRUCTIONS

JUNIOR SCHOOL FORMAL DRESS - #1 UNIFORM

Formal dress #1 uniform is required on Mondays, and for all official school functions and outings. #1 wear consists of the following:

#1 Uniform (K - Grade 3):

- Cardigan
- Junior School clip tie
- White dress shirt
- Grey dress pants (grey socks), tunic (navy knee-high socks or solid navy tights), or navy shorts* (navy socks)
- Yoga pants are not an acceptable option
- All-black dress shoes with enclosed front and back
- Blazer is optional
- Slides, mules, sandals, and slippers are not permitted

#1 Uniform (Grade 4 – 5):

- School blazer
- Junior School clip tie
- White dress shirt
- Grey dress pants (grey socks), kilt (navy knee-high socks or solid navy tight), or navy shorts* (navy socks)
- All-black dress shoes with enclosed front and back
- Slides, mules, sandals, and slippers are not permitted
- Yoga pants are not an acceptable option

**Please note that navy shorts may not be worn for Number One uniform after Thanksgiving and before Spring Break. Students are required to wear pants, kilt, or tunic for picture day.*

JUNIOR SCHOOL NORMAL DAILY WEAR - #2 UNIFORM

The normal daily wear school uniform, “#2” (Tuesday – Friday) consists of the following:

Normal Daily Wear (K - Grade 5):

- Polo shirt (navy or white) / Long sleeve mock neck
- Cardigan / Junior fleece hoodie
- Grey dress pants (grey socks), tunic, kilt, skort (navy knee-high socks or solid navy tights), or navy shorts* (navy socks)
- Yoga pants are not an acceptable option
- All-black dress shoes with enclosed front and back
- Slides, mules, sandals, and slippers are not permitted

JUNIOR PHYSICAL EDUCATION CLOTHING REQUIREMENTS

**Required starting in Grade 2.*

- Gym shirt – available through the uniform shop
- Gym shorts – available through the uniform shop
- Gym bag – available through the uniform shop
- Gym shoes – any type of running shoe is acceptable but they must have non-marking soles
- Gym socks – sport socks kept in the gym bag
- Zip hoodies and sweatpants are available but are not required

JUNIOR SCHOOL

KINDERGARTEN - GRADE 3

SENIOR SCHOOL INSTRUCTIONS

MIDDLE & HIGH SCHOOL FORMAL DRESS - #1 UNIFORM

Formal dress #1 uniform is required on Mondays, and for all official school functions and outings. #1 wear consists of the following:

Number One:

- Blazer
- Senior school tie
- White dress shirt
- Formal pants (grey or black), navy or black shorts*, kilt (must fall between the knee and mid-thigh)
- Navy knee-high socks, solid navy, grey, or black tights, grey or black socks
- Yoga pants are not an acceptable option
- All-black dress shoes with enclosed front and back
- Slides, mules, sandals, and slippers are not permitted

MIDDLE & HIGH SCHOOL NORMAL DAILY WEAR - #2

The normal daily wear school uniform, “#2” (Tuesday – Friday) consists of the following:

Normal Daily Wear:

- Polo shirt (navy, white, grey) / Long sleeve navy golf shirt
- Champion sweatshirt / Cardigan
- Aberdeen Hall or team issued athletic sweatshirt may be worn over top uniform
- Formal pants (grey or black), khaki dress pants (non denim), navy or black shorts*, kilt (must fall between knee and mid-thigh), Uniform Shop issued khaki skort (must fall between the knee and mid-thigh)
- Yoga pants are not an acceptable option
- Navy knee-high socks, solid navy, grey, or black tights, grey or black socks
- All-black dress shoes with enclosed front and back
- Slides, mules, sandals, and slippers are not permitted

**Please note that shorts may not be worn for #1 uniform after Thanksgiving and before Spring Break. Students are required to wear pants or kilt for picture day.*

MIDDLE & HIGH SCHOOL PHYSICAL EDUCATION CLOTHING REQUIREMENTS

- Gym shirt – available through from the uniform shop
- Gym shorts – school navy shorts / solid black shorts >4” inseam (no design or color) / solid black leggings (no design or color)
- Gym bag – available through the uniform shop
- Gym shoes – any type of running shoe is acceptable but they must have non-marking soles
- Gym socks – sport socks kept in the gym bag
- Track pants are available but are not required. If your student joins a sports team, track pants are mandatory for all team travel.

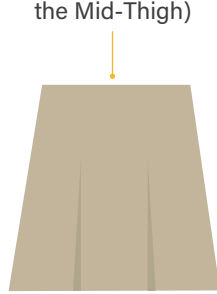
