Using the right technology is an essential part of education here at Aberdeen Hall. The ability to create, communicate, research and share is greater than ever before.

With the increased demand for online and blended learning, Aberdeen Hall has a BYOD program that requires students in Grade 6-12 to bring in their own devices for educational use while at school. The requirements for these devices are as follows:

A personal computer that has

- An English Operating System Chrome OS, Windows 10 or MacOS highly recommended
- Good battery life Students will want enough to get you through the day without needing to frequently charge their device
- The ability to connect to Wireless Internet
- An attached keyboard (iPad Accessory Keyboard also works)

School owned devices will still be used for projects that require specific software and operating systems so students do not need to bring in the most high-end, expensive machines on the market.
