Parking Expectations:

The school has limited parking and is available for Grade 12 students ONLY. Parking is required in the designated student parking lot across the street from the campus. Students may also park their vehicles appropriately on Academy Way. Student vehicles **must display a valid parking pass hanging from their rearview mirror, or risk being towed.** _____ **(Initial)**

In addition, the following guidelines are to be followed by all student drivers.

- Students are to adhere to all licensing rules outlined by the Graduated Licensing Program.
- The identified vehicle must be in a safe, roadworthy condition and the student's license must be in good standing.
- Students will drive in a safe, responsible manner at all times following all traffic laws and regulations.
- Students wishing to leave campus at lunch may do so only after signing out properly, but must return prior to the start of fourth block. They must also sign in upon returning to school.
- Students must not leave campus during class hours. In special circumstances (Doctor's appt, family event, etc.), specific written permission signed by a parent or guardian must be provided.
- If a student has more than one vehicle, it **must be registered** with the junior front office.
- Student drivers will not carry passengers during the school day.
- Students are not permitted to park on campus in any designated lots for parents or staff. _____ **(Initial)**
A "Three Strike" Program will be enforced to ensure students follow the above noted guidelines. If a student receives three strikes, their pass will be suspended or potentially revoked.
- Passes are not to be shared with others.
- The Grade 12 Grad lot is considered 'on school property.' As such, the school Code of Conduct is in effect for students parked in this area.
- Pass Deposit Fees: \$20/original & \$10/replacement. Students may return their pass at the end of the year to receive their deposit back (pass must be in good condition). Students who do not return their pass by June 25, 2027 forfeit the deposit paid. Additionally, suspended or revoked passes forfeit the deposit paid. Deposit fees are accepted in cash only to the Junior Reception desk.
